<u>POSITION SUMMARY</u>: This is a technical clerical position. The employee is responsible for performing quality control and maintaining the integrity of state commercial vehicle enforcement information by processing Driver/Vehicle inspection information and Commercial Vehicle Accidents information into the Federal SAFETYNET system.

QUALIFICATIONS: The following represents the minimum qualifications used to accept applicants, provided that equivalent substitution will be permitted in case of deficiencies in either experience or education.

Quality Control Clerk I: Possession of a high school diploma or equivalent and one year experience as a Clerk II or related clerical classification. **Quality Control Clerk II:** Possession of a high school diploma or equivalent and two years experience as a Quality Control Clerk I.

Completion of a typing test.

SALARY RANGE (Semi-monthly): The minimum starting salary is \$1,433.00; however, salary may be commensurate with experience.

<u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</u>: Final selection may be based upon several factors, e.g., results of an oral interview, written examination or exercise, review of past work performance, performance evaluations, and/or candidate's possession of the knowledge, skills, and abilities deemed necessary for successful performance in the job.
