POSITION AVAILABLE: Food Service Worker

SALARY RANGE (semi-monthly): The minimum starting salary for a Food Service Worker is \$1,588.00; however, salary may be commensurate with experience.

OFFICIAL DOMICILE: Jefferson City, Missouri

POSITION DESCRIPTION: This food service position will receive general supervision in preparing and cooking more complex menu items. An employee at this level is accountable for preparing simple menu items, and will follow specific dietary needs, standard kitchen procedures, and sanitation guidelines when handling, preparing, and serving food. An employee at this level will requisition basic food, supply items, and maintain point of service counts. They will also participate in assisting with cleaning the kitchen and food serving areas. Additional duties include washing dishes and kitchen tools, and stocking food in serving lines. This position is classified as non-exempt under the Fair Labor Standards Act

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Current Patrol personnel interested in this position must access the Patrol's [intranet](#) to complete and submit an [application](#) prior to the application deadline. Positions requiring educational qualifications require all interested applicants, who have not already done so, to upload a copy of their college transcripts to the online application system. Resumes will not be accepted in lieu of the application. Individuals who have previously completed an application must access their profile in the system to re-apply.

Interviews will be scheduled as applications are reviewed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Final selection may be based upon several factors, e.g., results of an oral interview, written examination or exercise, review of past work performance, performance evaluations, and/or candidate's possession of the knowledge, skills, and abilities deemed necessary for successful performance in the job.
